The Impact Summit has three goals: inspiration, empowerment, and community.

To inspire a spirit of social impact, we are inviting speakers from the social entrepreneurship sector including leaders of NGOs, founders of social startups, technological pioneers, impact investors, and philanthropists working to solve global hunger, climate change, gender inequalities, healthcare disparities, and inaccessible education in order to highlight those already taking the lead to make the world a better place.

To empower and support students to change the world, we are leading workshops and skillshares with technical specialists, especially highlighting AI and blockchain, recognizing that emerging technologies have an outsized role in shaping the future. We believe that students should have the chance to work with the current leaders at the intersection of tech and social impact, and so we are featuring a Social Impact Career Fair, allowing impactful and meaningful organizations to pair with the technical talent they need. Beyond that, we will host a Social Startup Competition, providing an opportunity for students working on meaningful projects to pitch their own ventures, make connections with industry leaders, and win funding.

To create a lasting community, we are organizing group discussions and breakout sessions with industry experts to provide a more intimate setting for like-minded students to explore areas of their own interests and engage with speakers one-on-one. We will also have time for several more casual programs that gives attendees a chance at genuine, personal connection.

Perhaps most importantly, we aim to spotlight the organizations that are doing well by doing good. Students across the country are becoming more frustrated by the idea of working for companies in which they have little influence, especially when the positive impacts of those companies are dubious at best. We hope to provide a clear alternative and illuminate the road less traveled by connecting students to the institutions that are tackling the social and environmental challenges of our era. Our mission is to inspire the most talented minds of our generation to seek meaning in their work, start social ventures with integrity, and take genuine steps to making the world a better place.

This is an ambitious initiative, and with any mission of this scale, it takes teamwork and collaboration to make it happen. If we can spark each and every student with the passion to tackle social challenges, we have the power to make a dramatic impact, and we would be honored to have you join us!
